



2016 Student Chapter Scholarship Application and Requirements

Mission:

To provide financial support for the professional development, training and networking of students seeking a career in the club management industry.

Scholarship Awards

The National Capital Club Managers Association will award one scholarship annually, based on the availability of funds and merit of applications. In order to help recipients further their professional development as students, who have an intended career path in club management, the scholarship will fund \$1,000 to be applied toward registration costs to any NCCMA Board-approved continuing education program (not just CMAA-related) and reimbursable expenses directly related to travel, lodging, etc.

The scholarship will be granted based on recommendations made by the NCCMA Scholarship Committee and approved by the NCCMA Board of Directors.

Who Should Apply

The scholarship is open to any student who has completed, at minimum, one internship at a Club and is a student of an accredited university hospitality program within Virginia, Maryland or Washington, DC.

Requirements

1. Digital Photograph of the Applicant
2. Current Resume
3. Completed Application (below)
4. Two Letters of Recommendation: One from either the applicant's CMAA chapter advisor or from a hospitality faculty member. The second from the General Manager or the applicants direct supervisor at one of their internship locations.
5. Essay highlighting the applicant's educational and internship goals and objectives during the remainder of the applicant's university studies. The essay should also describe which CMAA or other continuing education program the applicant desires to enroll in and why that particular program would be of benefit.
 - a. Essay may not exceed two pages
 - b. Typed, 12pt, Times New Roman font, single spaced
 - c. Deadline for requirements is **October 31, 2015.**

The NCCMA Student Chapter Scholarship winner will be determined by December 1st and announced at the chapter's Board of Governors Installation Dinner in January.
