



James T. "Jim" Troppman, Club Manager of the Year Award

Mission: The James T. "Jim" Troppman Award is a recognition acknowledging a member for his or her exemplified and distinguished professionalism; dedication to excellence; and enhancement to the image of Club management in the National Capital Chapter.

The award was created in 2013 and given to James T. "Jim" Troppman for his 35+ years of dedicated service as General Manager of Columbia Country Club and his dedication to Club Managers Association of America.

Criteria for consideration:

- Must have been a member of CMAA for 6 years;
- Must be a member of the National Capital Chapter for 3 years;
- Must be a current General Manager or Executive Leader/Senior Manager level of a club within the boundaries of the Chapter;
- Must have attended at least four meetings a year for the past two years;
- Must have served as a Chapter Director or Committee Chairperson or must have attained the Certified Club Manager (CCM) designation.

Other criteria to consider:

- Club work history;
- Special activity/activities that make this manager notable;
- Other boards/director positions in the hospitality/club industry;
- Other honors, achievements or contributions to the development of the club management profession through leadership, involvement and service;
- Commitment to continuing education.

Nominations: A Nominating Committee shall be formed each year, comprised of at least 4 Chapter Professional Members including the Chair plus the Chapter Managing Director who shall serve in an ex-officio capacity. The Board of Directors will review applicant submissions from NCCMA chapter members and submit to the Nominating Committee; the Nominating Committee will review the applicants and select the chosen recipient based on all criteria stated above and include a brief write-up/paragraph stating why said manager is deserving of the award.

The Managing Director will submit the final result to the Board of Directors for approval. The report of the James T. "Jim" Troppman Award Nominating Committee shall be made no later than October 31st to the Managing Director. (The James T. "Jim" Troppman Award is not required to be awarded every year). The Managing Director shall serve as the liaison to the Chapter Board and the Nominating Committee, and will present the recommendation of the Nominating Committee to the Board by the November board meeting.

The James T. "Jim" Troppman Club Manager of the Year award may be presented at the annual Chapter Installation and Awards Dinner in January and the honored manager will be presented a plaque. A complimentary table for ten guests, including the recipient, will be included at the annual Installation dinner.
